

White Wines

Chenin Blanc, Rocheburg – South Africa £18.95
Packed with upfront tropical fruit, the nose charms with an abundance of guava and gooseberries. The palate follows through with fruit flavours, balanced by a crisp acid to ensure a fresh and fruity style of wine

Piesporter Michelsberg – Germany £18.95
Perceptively drier than most of the Rhine wines at this level. Highly scented and opulent fruit but with a 'tighter knit' structure, light-bodied, medium-dry and delicate

Caoba Chardonnay – Argentine £19.95
Caoba is Spanish for Mahogany and South America is where a lot of the world's mahogany is from. This is a medium weight unoaked Chardonnay with spritzzy apple, pear and melon flavours and a long lasting finish. In fact, its flavour packed and is a good accompaniment to all but the spiciest of foods

Muscadet Sur Lie – France £21.95
A classic Muscadet from the Loire valley. Clean, crisp and dry. Perfect with fish or as an accompaniment to your starter

Triplica Fiano/Falanghina/Greco – Italy £21.95
Interesting and misleading, this Campania white, made from the areas three indigenous grapes has a sweet, floral bouquet but a palate which adds a hint of spice and finishes with an unexpected burst of dry flavours. Fiano gives an aromatic and honeyed sweetness.

Macon Blanc Villages AC Lalboure Roi – France £23.95
Delicious thirst quenching, easy to drink white Burgundy. Aromas of bruised orchard apples and tropical citrus fruit. Soft, but with crisp acidity.

Giesen Estate Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand £25.95
Delicious variety of flavours, excellent body and weight. A richer style of Sauvignon, elegantly restrained with hints of lemon, lime, pineapple and grapefruit

Chablis Laboure Roi – Burgundy, France £33.95
A good example of this world famous white wine – Steely dry with delicate, minerally Chardonnay fruit. Fresh and lively on the palate. A focussed palate is followed by persistent lemony finish
